

Republican Party of Sheboygan County
Executive Committee Meeting
November 14, 2016

Chairman Dennis Gasper called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were: Dennis Gasper, Judy Gasper, Darryl Carlson, Phil Parker, Paul Gruber, Art DeJong, Senator Devin LeMahieu, and Joel Urmanski.

Secretary Judy Gasper distributed printed copies of the October meeting minutes, which had also been emailed to committee members prior to the meeting. Darryl made a motion to accept the minutes as distributed, motion seconded by Paul, motion carried.

Treasurer Phil Parker presented the Treasurer's Report. We have a \$13,500 cash balance and no outstanding large bills. Judy made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report for audit, motion was seconded by Darryl, motion carried.

Judy Gasper reported that we now have 188 members, an increase of 14 members since our October meeting.

Old Business

The election results were briefly discussed. Sheboygan County had a much greater turnout for the election than most of the state. Art suggested sending thank-yous to our most outstanding volunteers and people who put up signs. Judy will mail thank-yous to volunteers and Paul will make personal calls to those who displayed large signs.

New Business

The county caucus to be held January 20th was discussed. We must have nominations for board members; we went around the table, and it was determined that all current board members will probably accept nomination to a new term. Suggested nominations to the county caucus committees were:

Resolutions committee: Art DeJong & Dennis Gasper

Credentials committee: Judy Gasper; another nominee needed

Rules committee: Paul Gruber & Darryl Carlson

Nominations will be finalized at our December meeting; we will also need nominees to serve on the 6th District caucus committees and as delegates.

The Call to Caucus and 2017 membership letter will be sent out in December between Christmas and New Year's.

John Revelis, our landlord, arrived and a new 2-year lease for our headquarters was signed.

There was discussion regarding putting our board meeting times and minutes on our website, and all agreed that we should do that.

Dennis suggested putting leftover 4 x 8 Trump/Pence signs up for sale for \$50 each. All agreed he should do so.

Mayor Mike Vandersteen and John Belanger have both announced they will be running for mayor in the spring election. It was agreed that they will be allowed to use our posts and PVC for their signs if they become members of the county party.

It was decided not to worry about resuming our GOP Roundtables until after the holidays. Possible guests: the judges up for election in spring, DA Joel Urmanski discussing human trafficking.

There being no further business, Paul moved to adjourn, second by Darryl, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
