- 1. Vice-chairman Darryl Carlson called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. Those present were: Darryl Carlson, Carmen Dolson, Paul Gruber, Phil Parker, Art DeJong, and Kevin O'Brian
- 3. Art DeJong distributed copies of the March meeting minutes, which had previously been emailed to committee members. Paul moved to accept the minutes as distributed, motion seconded and carried.
- 4. Treasurer Phil Parker reported that \$1,915.00 had come in since the last meeting and \$2,393.10 had gone out, for a checking account balance of \$13,681.47. Paul moved to accept the report. Motion seconded and carried.
