

Republican Party of Sheboygan County
Executive Committee Meeting Minutes
January 14, 2019

Chairman Dennis Gasper called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Senator LeMahieu was thanked for the donation of a Wisconsin state flag that had flown over the capitol.

Those present were: Dennis Gasper, Darryl Carlson, Judy Gasper, Jan Vojta, Carmen Dolson, Art DeJong, Paul Gruber, Senator Devin LeMahieu, Rep. Tyler Vorpapel, Rep. Terry Katsma, and Al Jante.

Secretary Judy Gasper distributed copies of the December meeting minutes, which had also been emailed to committee members. There being no additions or corrections, Darryl made a motion to accept the minutes as distributed, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried.

Treasurer Jan Vojta reported that we began 2019 with a cash balance of \$11,656.47. \$2,350.00 in contributions have been received this month, mostly memberships, some miscellaneous; expenses total \$251.32. This leaves us with a cash balance of \$13,755.15. Carmen made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report for audit, motion seconded by Darryl, motion carried.

Judy Gasper reported that our 2019 membership is now 104.

Al Jante reported that electronic media activity remains low since the November election. Our Mail Chimp account is costing \$20 per month because our email list exceeds the minimum for a free account. Darryl made a motion to authorize the payment of \$20 per month for the Mail Chimp account; motion was seconded by Jan, motion carried.

Martha Jensema has notified the Chairman that she will not be able to serve on the credentials committee at the county caucus because of a family medical emergency. Jan Vojta made a motion to replace her with Ellen Vojta, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried.

Darryl Carlson, member of the nominating committee, made the following nominations for the Sixth District Caucus:

Credentials Committee – Julie Vale and Jane Kautzer; second by Judy, carried

Rules Committee – Paul Gruber and Jake Immel; second by Carmen, carried

Resolutions Committee – Art DeJong and Al Jante; second by Carmen, carried

A list of suggested delegates to the Sixth District Caucus and State Convention was distributed. Carmen made a motion to approve the list, motion seconded by Art, motion carried.

Martha Jensema has withdrawn her name from consideration for the position on the Executive Committee being vacated by Carmen Dolson. Darryl nominated Greg Quella for the position, second by Carmen, carried. County caucus preparations were reviewed.

Darryl reported that the District Caucus will be held in Green Lake County at a location yet to be determined on March 9th or April 13th. The state convention will be held the weekend of May 18th at the Best Western in Oshkosh.

The Lincoln Reagan date is still unknown; we are waiting for a decision on Rachel Duffy's availability.

There was a discussion about whether we should purchase Hagedorn for Supreme Court signs. Paul made a motion to authorize purchases not to exceed \$2200, motion seconded by Darryl, motion carried.

The next meeting will be Monday, February 11th.

Senator LeMahieu, Rep. Katsma, and Rep. Vorpapel provided a legislative update.

There being no further business, Darryl made a motion to adjourn, Carmen seconded the motion, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
