

REPUBLICAN PARTY OF SHEBOYGAN COUNTY
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2018

Chairman Dennis Gasper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were: Dennis Gasper, Darryl Carlson, Judy Gasper, Paul Gruber, Art DeJong, Carmen Dolson, Al Jante, Senator Devin LeMahieu, Rep. Terry Katsma, Rep. Tyler Vorpapel, and Sheriff Cory Roeseler.

Secretary Judy Gasper distributed copies of the August meeting minutes, which had also been emailed to committee members. There being no additions or corrections, Darryl made a motion to accept the minutes as distributed, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried.

In the absence of Treasurer Jan Vojta, Chairman Gasper presented the Treasurer's Report prepared by Jan. We currently have cash on hand of \$13,179.32, which includes a checking account balance of \$12,143.79, a Paypal balance of \$949.53, and petty cash of \$86.00. We made a profit of \$1,298.60 on the August Golf Outing. Paul made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report for audit, motion seconded by Darryl, motion carried.

Judy Gasper reported that we now have 210 members, an increase of four since our last meeting.

Al Jante reported on the Electronic Media Committee. We now have 173 subscribers to our texts, an increase over last month's 116 subscribers. Two texts were sent out in the past month. We have spent \$11 of our \$200 investment in texting. Two Mail Chimp emails were sent out during the past month, also.

Dennis reviewed the results of the county fair. \$911 was spent on t-shirts, hats, buttons, stickers, etc.; we had revenue of \$2,030, leaving us with a net profit of \$1,119. We would have sold more shirts if we had more XL's and XXL's.

The September 20th Corn Roast was discussed. It was decided to plan for 50-60 attendees. Paul has secured a donation of six dozen Old Wisconsin hot dogs; Carmen will get the corn from our annual donor source and take care of other details. Phone calls will be made to request salads and desserts from volunteers. Darryl said he and his daughters will clean and set up before the event.

Dennis has been told that RPW is sending Chris Grawine to split time between our headquarters and Fond du Lac. Chris is a Washington, D.C. Grothman staffer.

Our next meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 8th.

The lease agreement for our headquarters will be revised per comments from committee members prior to the next meeting.

The Grothman campaign has planned a brunch fundraiser at our headquarters on September 29th.

It's possible that Governor Walker will stop at our headquarters when passing through the area this fall. We will wait to hear from his campaign.

Rep. Katsma said that he is holding a fundraiser in Oostburg on September 17th and is pleased that Attorney General Brad Schimel will be attending.

There being no further business, Paul made a motion to adjourn, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
